Application Details—

Urban Connections Interns are committing to 3-6 months of ministry, working alongside and accountable to the UC Executive Director, including weekly mentoring meetings.

Deadlines for application are as follows: Summer intern by April 15; Fall intern by July 15; Winter intern by October 15; Spring intern by January 15. Applicant will receive response within two weeks of the deadline.

Personal Qualifications—

The individual must be a disciple of Jesus Christ, showing the fruit of the Spirit.

The individual should be teachable and able to work within the context of a team.

The individual should be self-motivated and have good leadership potential, with the ability to translate ideas and concepts into working programs.

This person should be an active member or participant of a Christian community.

This person should be one who loves and relates well with people of different ages and backgrounds.

Responsibilities—

Responsibility for planning and organizing programs or events, as determined alongside UC Staff.

Participation in UC Activities, such as Kid Connection Clubs & Day Camps, camping trips, block parties or other community-focused celebrations, community meetings, outreach events, and regularly-scheduled community clean-up work.

Attend weekly mentoring and biweekly staff meetings.

Read one of the following books and write a 3-5page response paper to it: *Beyond Charity* (John Perkins), *Toxic Charity* (Bob Lupton), *When Helping Hurts* (Corbett & Fikkert), *Roadmap to Reconciliation* (Brenda Salters McNeil), *I'm Still Here* (Austin Channing Brown), or *White Fragility* (Robin DiAngelo). All of the books are available to borrow from UC.

Room & Board at UC house, including some meals. *This is encouraged but not required.*
